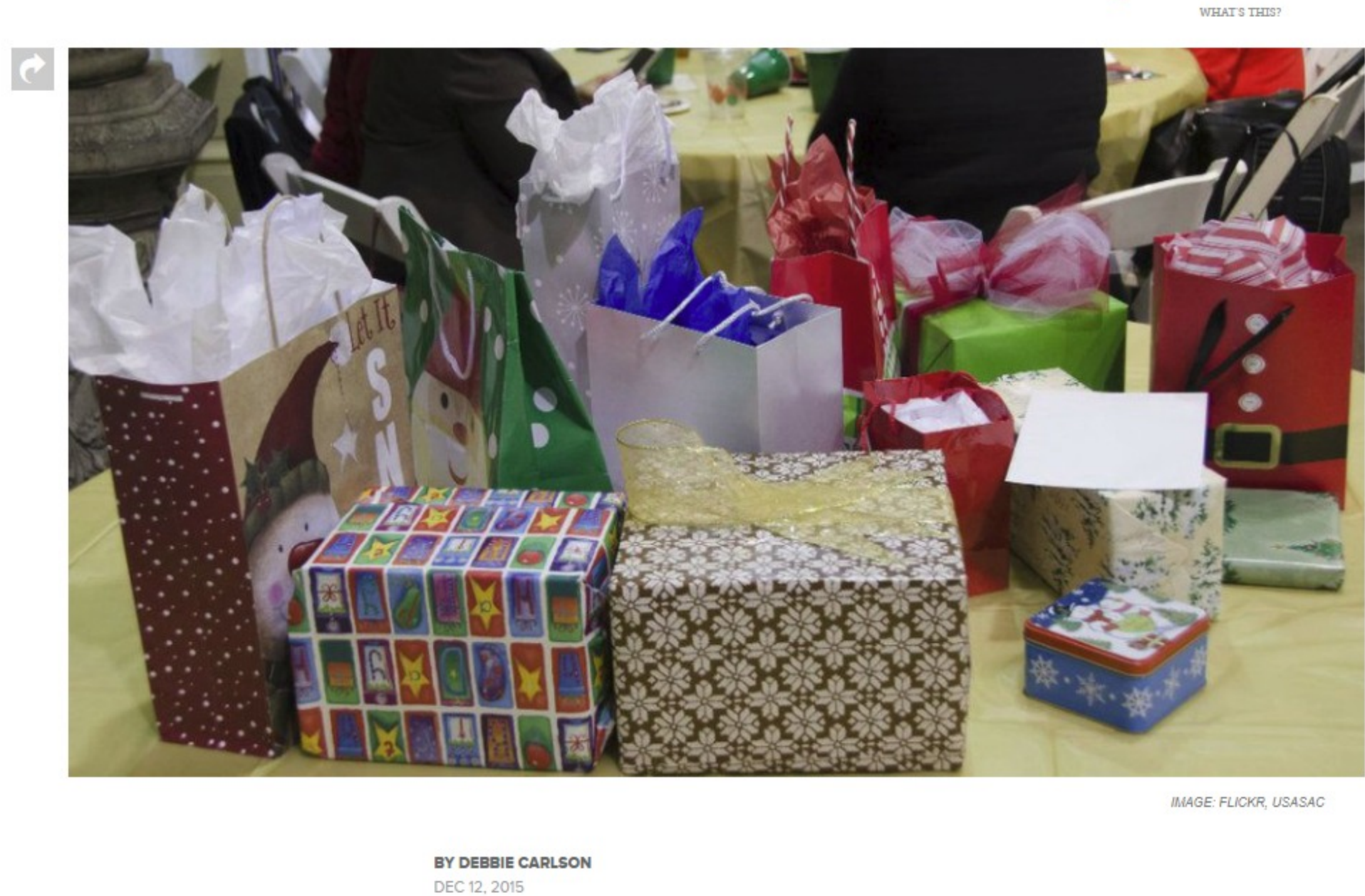


# 16 perfect Christmas gifts for your co-workers

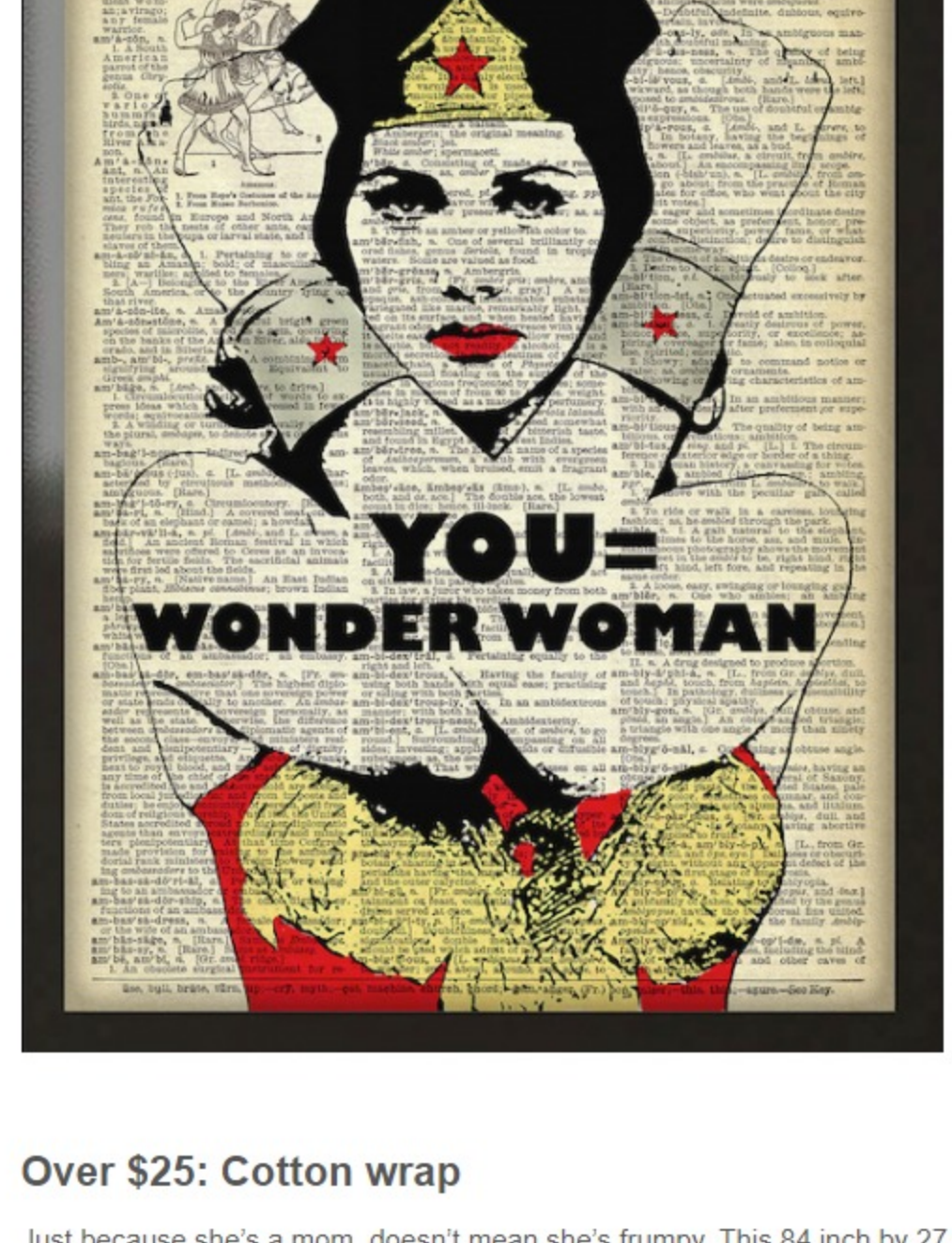
Giving work associates gifts this year?

**Over \$25: Bears for Humanity Teddy Bear**

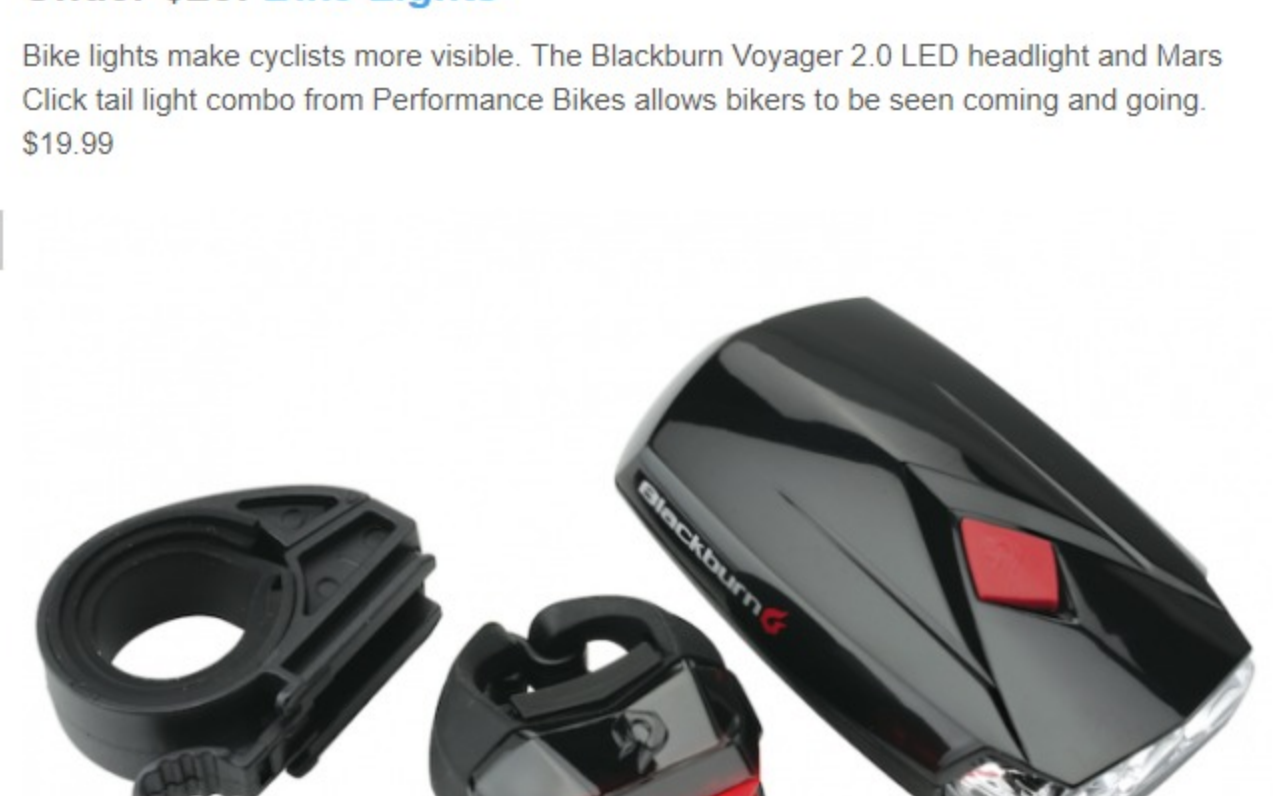

## 5. Bike Commuter

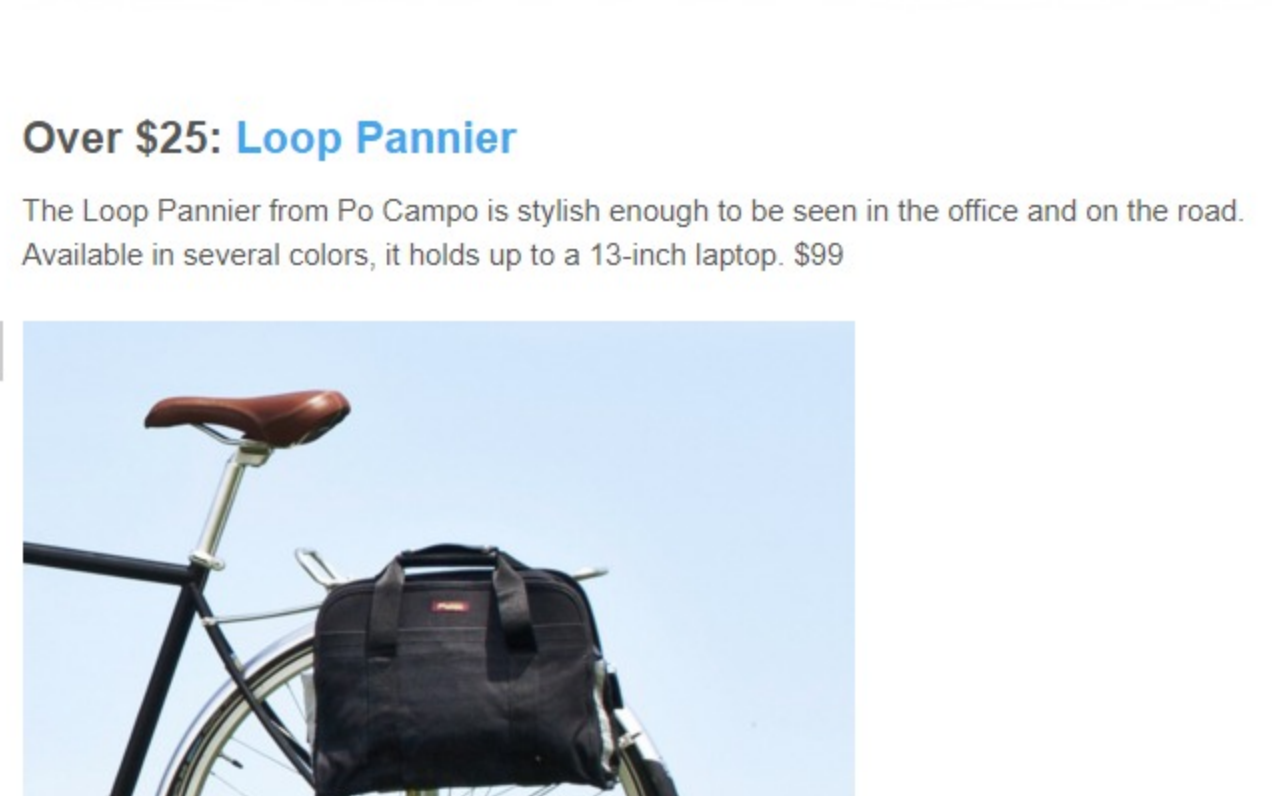
**Under \$25: Bike Lights**

**Over \$25: Bento Stainless Lunch Jar**

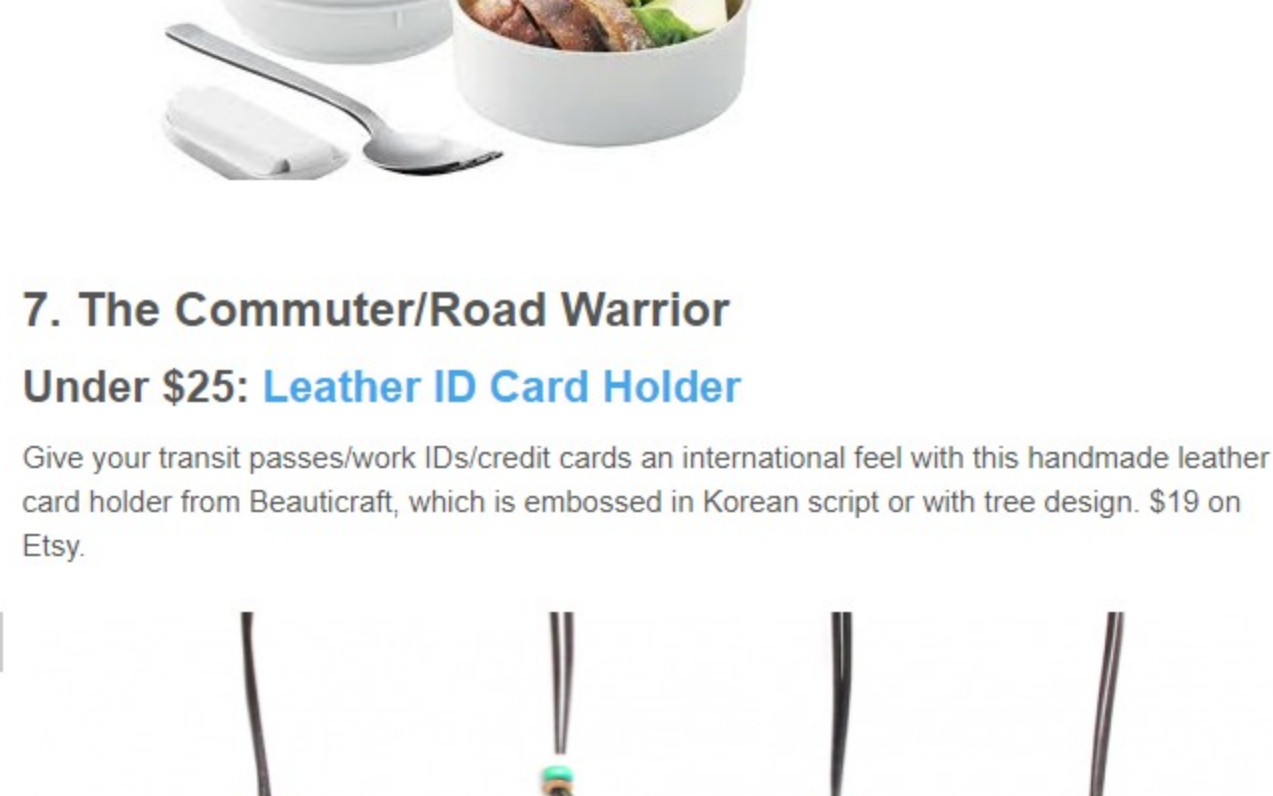

**Over \$25: Waterfield Padded Gear Pouch**

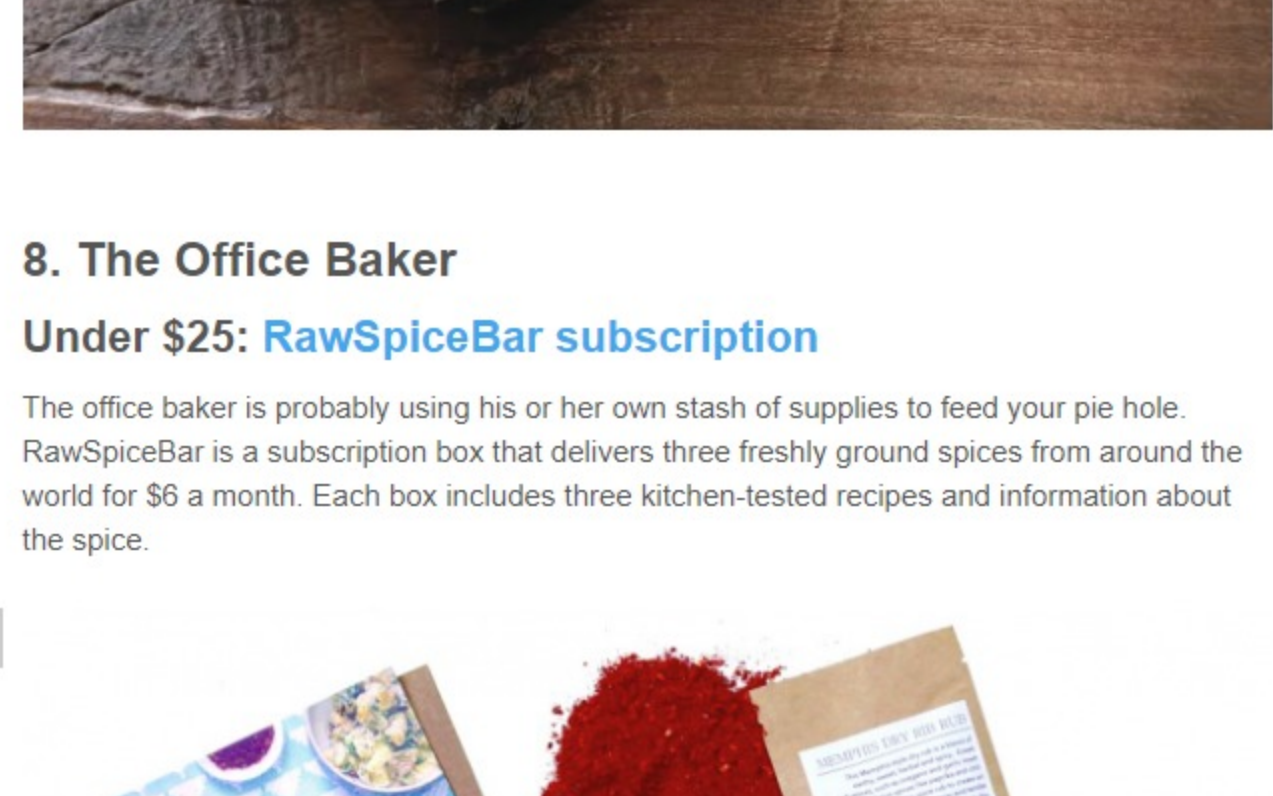
The padded gear pouch from Waterfield Designs keeps all necessary items in one place. Made in US. \$59. [See it](#)
